

Highly Successful INDIA ITME-2016

1100 Exhibitors, 38 Countries, 17 Chapters, 11 Exhibiting Halls, 24 Product Launches over 6 days period of exhibition made India ITME-2016 the largest and apex exhibition for Textile machinery and Technology in India. A total of 1,17,000 footfall from 74 countries visited India ITME-2016.

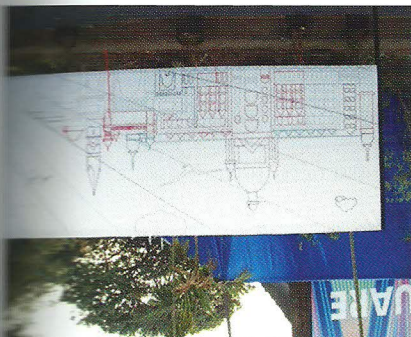
Stall Presence of Spinning Textiles at INDIA ITME 2016

Various theme and thematic installations by MIT Pune created delightful settings for domestic and international visitors.

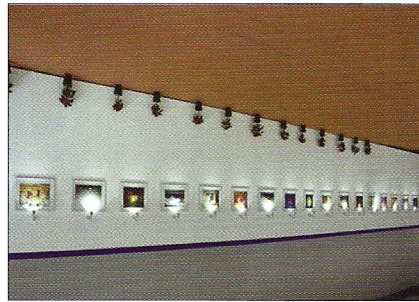
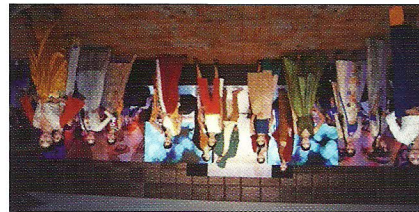
